Should I be doing this? Why do we do it this way? Is there a better way?

How many times did you want to ask these questions but didn't have time? I hear them a lot as a clinical nurse specialist. A procedure or guideline may have answers, but they often lead to more questions. Where do we turn when we truly don't know what to do?

I urge my colleagues to practice according to the best available evidence. Follow the evidence, I tell them, and I know I've influenced the practice of someone who challenges me to show them the evidence.

The promise nurses make to patients and families involves doing our best for them by using the best practices available. We stand tall and fulfill our promise when our practice is evidence-based. Evidence-based practice (EBP) is a widely used term. However, like beauty, what constitutes evidence seems to be in the eye of the beholder. Definitions and perspectives vary from caregiver to caregiver, although most seem to agree it means to find, review and grade available research then make an informed practice decision based on the results.

Doing that can be complex and takes time. It may not even be that interesting to many of us, which is where AACN comes in.
